Luke 21:15 - 17

**What's Wrong With Christianity?
 "Just about everything".**

Let's start out with three biblical passages that are the boundaries of what worship is all about, but first, we have learned that the Messiah (Christ), is the only begotten son of Yahweh the Father. His name is Yahshua, and that Jesus was **never** His real name. Some people would say Messiah's name is Yeshua, but that is because the Jews will not pronounce or use the name "Yah", that we find written in Psalm 68:4. Also, considering that there was no "J" in the languages before the 16th century. None of the biblical characters names starts with the letter "J", such as Joshua, Job, Joseph, John, Jonah, Joel, etc.

1. John 8:58 Yahshua said to them, "Most assuredly, I tell you, before Abraham came into existence, I AM."

The Jews of His day tried to kill him for saying "I Am". Why? Because Yahshua was the only begotten son of the Father, Yahweh, which no human has ever seen, *John 6:46*). How then did Joseph's virgin wife Miriam get pregnant? A sperm was created. That's how people are made, and that was how our Savior was made flesh. *(They say one sperm contains 37.5MB of data. Look it up.)* All mammals reproduce with one sperm and an egg. If God created Adam, God could create a sperm. (Just my thought.)

2. Matthew 11:27 All things have been delivered to me by my Father. No one knows the Son, except the Father; neither does anyone know the Father, except the Son, and he to whom the Son desires to reveal him. What we are going to go over is proof that neither the Father or the Son are truly known by many people.

3. Why "parables".

Matthew 13:10 The **disciples** came, and said to him (Yahshua), "Why do you speak to them (His audience) in parables (allegories)?" 11 He answered them (Yahshua's disciples), "**To you it is given to know the mysteries** of the Kingdom of Heaven, but it **is not given to them**. *(His audience, in person or in the pages of the Bible.)* 12 For whoever **has**, to him will be given, and he will have **abundance**, but whoever **does not have**, from him will be **taken away even that which he has**. 13 Therefore I speak to them in parables, **because seeing they do not see**, and hearing, **they do not hear, neither do they understand**. 14 In them the prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled, which says, 'By hearing you will hear, And will in no way understand; Seeing you will see, and will in no way perceive: 15 For

this people's heart has grown callous, Their ears are dull of hearing, They have closed their **eyes**; Or else perhaps they might perceive with their **eyes**, **hear** with their **ears**, **Understand** with **their heart**, And should **turn again**; And I would heal them.' 16 "But blessed are your eyes, for they see; and your ears, for they hear. 17 For most assuredly I tell you that many prophets and righteous men desired to see the things which **you see**, and did not see them; and to hear the things which **you hear**, and **did not hear them**.

The three things we just read should give us a clue as to what the problem is with mainstream Christianity today. The roots of Christianity evolved **not** from the Bible, but rather from The First Council of Nicaea. It was a council of so called Christian bishops convened in the Bithynian city of Nicaea by the Roman Emperor **Constantine 1st** in AD 325. This ecumenical council was the first effort to attain consensus in the "church" through an assembly representing all Christendom. (Wikipedia)

Accepted by: The Roman Catholic Church, the Eastern Orthodox Church, the Oriental Orthodox Church, the Assyrian Church of the East, and the Ancient Church of the East. And now there are over 1,100 denominations or more. The question to be asked is "which one is the right one" because they all differ in one way or another. That question led me to write this article:

There are 14 important points that sum up this conclusion.

1. The Sabbath. The first and most obvious is the Christian day of worship. The Bible plainly states in many places (116 places) that there is only one weekly day of worship and that is confirmed in the fourth commandment of the ten commandments. The Ten Commandments remain in effect, Matthew 19:17
 Genesis 2:3 God (Elohim, plural) blessed the seventh day, and made it holy (set apart) because he rested in it from all his work which he had created and made.
 Isaiah 66:23 It shall happen, that from one new moon to another, and from one Sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, says Yahweh.
 Exodus 16:30 So the people rested on the seventh day. The seventh day is the sabbath of Yahweh your Mighty One: in it you shalt not do any (laborious) work.
 Hebrews 4:4 For he has said this somewhere about the seventh day, "Yahweh rested on the seventh day from all his works," 5 and in this place again, "They will not enter into my rest"(the kingdom of God). 6 Seeing therefore it remains that **some** should enter therein, and they to whom the good news was before preached **failed to enter in because of disobedience**. (They failed to keep the Commandments.)

Mark 1:21 They (the Apostles) went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath day He (Messiah Yahshua, Jesis) entered into the synagogue and taught. *Why did He do that?*

Because it says in: Luke 4:16 He (Yahshua) came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. He entered, **as was his custom**, into the synagogue on **the Sabbath day**, and stood up to read. *Sunday is nowhere mentioned in the Bible as the day of worship.*

Again, the word Sabbath occurs 116 times in the KJV Bible. So Christians worship on the Venerable Day of the Sun god instead, not on the Sabbath, Saturday.

Gal 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Messiah Yeshua. *At least the Jews managed to understand keeping the Sabbath on the correct day.*

2. The Trinity. It is a false, man made doctrine. Unlike all beings, both human and spirit beings, each one of them all have a name. The Holy Spirit, on the other hand, has no name at all. Why is that? Because **It** is a power, and **It** is not a personality. Most bibles translate the word as **“he”** when in fact **It** is a power or Force that Elohim (God) uses and controls. God gives his Holy Spirit or takes it away from people at his discretion.

In Judaism, the Holy Spirit (ruach ha-kodesh) refers to the divine **force**, quality, and influence of Elohim over the universe or over Yahweh's creatures, in given contexts. *Definition from Barn's Notes.*

This is an example of how the Holy Spirit works: Luke 2:26 It had been revealed to him (*Simeon*) by the Holy Spirit that he (an old man) should not see death before he had seen Yahweh's (God the Fathers) Messiah.

There is no such thing as a trinity, It's a lie, and a trinity is something that could never be explained using the Bible. It is a false theological invention of man. The fact is that there are only two beings in the so called Godhead. One of them, the Father, and has never been seen by any human. The other one was the God of the Scriptures (Old Testament) and the Savior, Yahshua (Jesus) in the New Testament. John 5:37 The Father himself, who sent me (Yahshua Messiah), has testified about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his form.

Uh-Oh? Who was The Lord or God of the Old Testament? That's right; the one that was born human and died for our sins. Yahshua Messiah, was the God of the Old Testament before his human birth, the same individual, born in the flesh like any other human being. In other words He was the creator God, He became human, He was murdered and lay dead, He was raised from the dead by Father Yahweh in Heaven, He returned to his original estate as the second member of the

Godhead in Heaven, soon to return as King of Kings to rule the World for 1,000 years after His return with the resurrected saints.

3. Born again. Think about this term. We are born. We will die. We will be born a second time. The first birth was from our mother. The second birth will be supernatural and not in the same way we were born the first time through our mother. How does it work? There are two separate resurrections from the dead. The first re-birth can be read about in 1Corinthians chapter 15:12-52. That birth is to spirit life, and is exactly like Yahshua, after his death. He was resurrected when he ascended back to Heaven from where he came in the first place.

1John 3:1 Behold, how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of Yahweh! For this cause the world does not know us, because it did not know Him 2: Beloved, now we are children of Yahweh (unborn), and it is not yet revealed what we will be, but we know that, when he is revealed, we will be **like him**; for we will see him just as he is. (This is the “first and better of two resurrections”. See Hebrews 11:35 to the end. In context. It is important for you to read those six verses.

The second resurrection is understood by very few, but is explained in Ezekiel 37:1-14, and mentioned as “the rest of the dead” in Revelation chapter 20 verse 5 where it says “The rest of the dead lived not again until the Thousand years are finished”. These millions/billions of people that will be raised back to physical life a second time and will be subject to the second death Rev 2:11, 20:6, 20:14, & Rev 21:8. look it up. The second death simply means that a person can die a second time if they are flesh and blood and breathing.

4. What is death? Death is the absence of life. It’s as simple as that. When the breath stops, the life stops. This is so simple and clearly explained: Ecclesiasties 9:5 For the living know that they will die, but the dead do not know anything, neither do they have any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten. (Until they are resurrected.) All people die and rot in the earth. All people will be resurrected at some time in the future either as a spirit being or as flesh and blood as we read in Ezekiel 37:1-14 Read about the valley of the dry bones. Then read Rev 20:5.

5. Heaven. Who is there now? Only two individuals. “Two only”. Your dead uncle Melvin is not in Heaven and neither is any one else including the most righteous of all mankind.

John 3:13 **No one has ascended into Heaven**, but he who descended out of heaven, the Son of Man, who is in Heaven.

This is true or Yahshua (His real name) is a liar. All dead things eventually return to the dust and dirt. All human beings will be brought back from the dirt to life a second time right here on planet Earth, after the Millennium and Satan is gone forever.

6. Hell. Who's there? Everyone that is dead except for one person. Since "no one has ascended into Heaven (see #5), where did they go? The Young's Literal Translation of Daniel 12:2 explains: "And the multitude of those sleeping in the dust of the ground will awake, some to life eternal, and some to reproaches, some to everlasting abhorrence" (The lake of fire). There are 4 words translated hell: Sheol (Hebrew) and Hades (Greek) simply mean a grave where we put dead people. Gehenna (hell fire) has not been lit yet, but it will be lit sometime in the distant future. People burning in hell for ever and ever is an absolute lie. Hell fire burns up to oblivion. It's that simple. See also Isaiah 26:19 "Your dead shall live; MY dead bodies shall arise". "Awake and sing, you who dwell in the dust; for your dew is as the dew of herbs, and **the earth shall cast forth the dead**". In other words, It's not over for all humanity. These resurrected people will live a long life. Isaiah 65:17-25. This is how it works read: Ezekiel 37:1-14 one more time. Read it!

7. What is sin. There is only one verse in the Bible that defines what sin is. Only one: 1John 3:4 Who ever commits sin transgresses also the law, for sin is the transgression of the Law. What Law? Romans 7:12 Wherefore the Law is holy, and the commandments holy, and just, and good. Matthew 19:16 One came to Him (Messiah) and said, "Good teacher, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?" 7 He said to him, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but one, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the (ten) commandments. The 7th day Sabbath, the 8 Holy days, and the clean food laws. It's not difficult, and Christians don't seem to understand these Laws are still in effect today.

8. What is necessary to be "Saved"? The brother of Messiah explains that: James 2:17 Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead in itself. What is works? Obedience. Doing what God (Yahweh) says. Obedience to God's commandments alone will not save any one, but Faith alone will not save anyone either. It takes both faith & works. (see #7)

9. Was Je-Zuse a Christian name? Yes, but no **biblical name** would ever begin with the letter "J". First of all the letter "J" was not in the languages of English, Hebrew, or Greek before the year 1,500. Britannica: "J", the tenth letter of the alphabet. It was not differentiated from the letter "I" until comparatively modern times. John 5:43 I have come in my Father's name, and you do not receive me. If

another comes in his own name, you will receive him. What is his father's name? Isaiah 42:8 I am Yahweh, that is my name; and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to engraved images.

A proper translation of Psalm 68:4 Sing to Elohim (God)! Sing praises to **his name!** Extol him who rides on the clouds: **Yah, his name!** Rejoice before him! The Messiah's true name is YahShua (meaning: Yahweh's salvation). The influence of the Jews who never say or write "Yah" because of what they did in Jeremiah chapter 44:26, they will never use Yahweh's **true**, and very important, name.

Something to consider. There are over 10,000 distinct denominations in 238 countries which is found online. As had mentioned at the beginning, another site indicated some 1,100 major Christian denominations exist world wide. This begs the question, which Christian denomination has their doctrine biblically correct in order to achieve salvation if you follow their doctrines?

What then is the one and only true "church" of the Bible?

It is the Bible itself,

and no other book is needed. if you look it up you will find the two words, "The Way" used 340 times in the popular King James version. There is no specific "true church organization" anywhere on this planet. Salvation and faith are between **each individual** and Yahweh the Father, through Yahshua Messiah, our savior, the only Son of Yahweh. Below is why: Yahshua, at Passover, the night before he was put to death, was saying to his disciples...

John 16:22-31 Therefore you now have sorrow, but I will see you again, and your heart will rejoice, and no one will take your joy away from you. 23 "In that day you will ask me no questions. Most assuredly I tell you, whatever you may ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you. 24 Until now, you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be made full. 25 I have spoken these things to you in figures of speech. But the time is coming

when I will no more speak to you in figures of speech, but will tell you plainly about the Father. 26 In that day you will ask in my (real) name; and I do not say to you, that I will pray to the Father for you, 27 for the Father himself loves you, because you have loved me, and have believed that I came forth from Yahweh. 28 I came out from the Father, and have come into the world. Again, I leave the world, and go back to the Father." 29 His disciples said to him, "OK! Now you speak plainly, and not in veiled language (parables)". 30 Now we know that you know all things, and do not need for anyone to question you. By this we believe that you came forth from Yahweh". 31 Yahshua answered them, "Do you now believe?"

After 3 days and 3 nights, Yahweh the Father raised Yahshua from the dead as spirit being, and He is now back in his original estate at the right hand of the Father until His return at the end of this present age.

Does this information make you uncomfortable?

We are coming to the end of this present age. A new age will begin during this present generation of mankind: Youtube "**Messiah 2030**".

Matthew 24:34 "Truly, I say to you, **this generation** shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled". Read the whole chapter.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, **if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect**. Who are the very elect? The answer is, those people that have done what is required according to what is written within the pages of the Bible from Genesis through Revelation. Matthew 11:30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. There definitely are requirements, but anyone that wants to can do what is necessary. Some will reject it because the requirements do not fit with their day to day schedule, and many other people will simply say something like this: "I have been a devout Catholic, Baptist, Mormon, or Christian all my life, so, what would my family and friends say"? Seriously, does it really matter what anyone else thinks when it comes to a persons salvation? As follower of the biblical savior of all mankind, read this:

Matthew 11:29 Take the yoke I give you. Put it on your shoulders and learn from me. I am gentle and humble, and you will find rest. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." *Definition of the word Yolk: A yoke is a wooden beam sometimes used between a pair of oxen or muels to enable them to pull together on a load when working in pairs.*

My point: If brothers and sisters in “The Way” can do what is required, **so can you**, but you can count on some bumps along the road. The Bible says so. Read these verses below to understand the bumps: READ

Matthew 5:11, 10:18, 10:39, 16:25, Mark 8:35, 10:29, 13:9, Luke 9:24.

It requires a commitment, and the commitment is between yourself and the God of the Bible and His son, and baptism in Yahshua’s name. By the way, prayer works if you believe. *Matthew 7:7*
